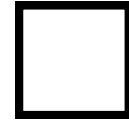

Scavenger Hunt



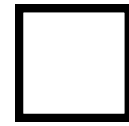
Find a ladybug



Ladybugs like to land on leaves to lay their eggs.



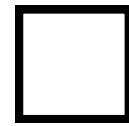
Find a bee



Bees collect pollen on the tiny hairs that they have on their legs and they carry it back to their hive.



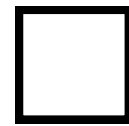
Find a squirrel



Squirrels like to jump from tree branch to tree branch when out searching for food.



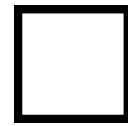
Find a caterpillar



Caterpillars can be found on leaves, on tree bark or sometimes even on the sidewalk.



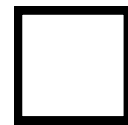
Find a chickadee



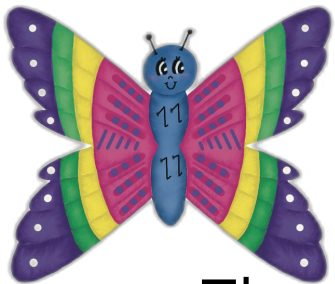
Chickadees can be found all throughout North America, Canada & Mexico in the trees and at feeding stations



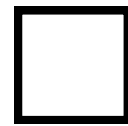
Find a pink flower



Petunias and Phlox are 2 types of flowers that come in pink and both attract butterflies.



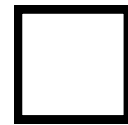
Find a butterfly
